Patient sustained a significant shoulder laceration from a fall. Wound was flushed with saline and antibiotics, Regenaflex-M was applied, covered with gauze, and a drain was sutured in.

At 3-month recheck, significant healing was noted with minimal scarring where Regenaflex-M was used.

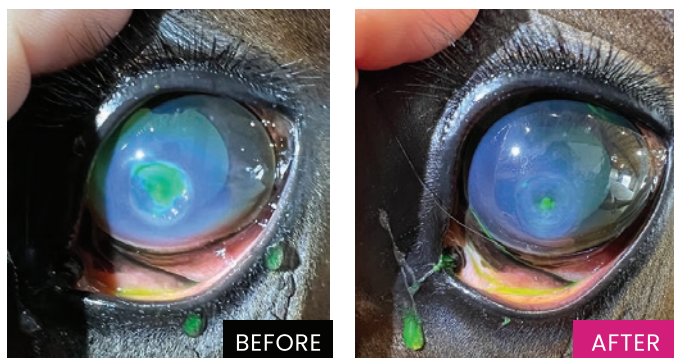

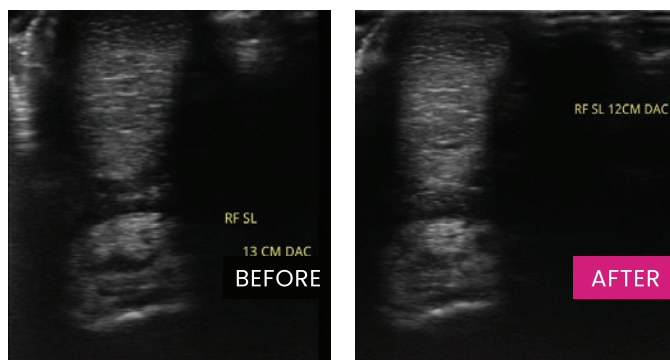


Following bilateral CCL repairs, patient was experiencing chronic discomfort and intermittent lameness in her hind end. Regenaflex-K9 was administered intramuscularly near the stifles.

At the 2-month recheck, mobility and energy had improved and play behavior resumed.

Regenaflex-RT® Suspensory Ligament Tear Case

Patient presented with lameness at a walk due to a significant proximal-mid body suspensory ligament tear. Regenaflex-RT was injected directly into the lesion and used in regional limb perfusion.

One month later ultrasound showed significant improvement, and the patient returned to comfortable walk/trot/canter work in under a year.
